THE JEANNE GEIGER CRISIS CENTER is a nonprofit social justice organization responding to the needs of local families victimized by domestic violence. Our mission is to empower individuals and engage communities to end domestic violence. We serve adults and children from 15 different communities in Essex County.

HOW DO WE HELP?

We use a wide variety of proven approaches to meet the complex needs of each family member. Not only do we provide advocacy, therapeutic counseling and legal services, we design and implement prevention programs in our local schools.

DID YOU KNOW...

- The Center provides advocacy services to 1,200-1,400 adults every year.
- Our services are provided at no cost to survivors and their families.
- The F.B.I. calculates that a woman is beaten every nine seconds. 72% of all murder-suicides involve intimate partners, and 94% of the victims of murder-suicides are female.

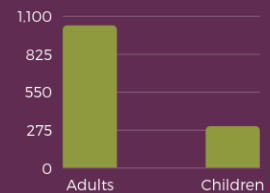
FY18 YEAR END STATISTICS

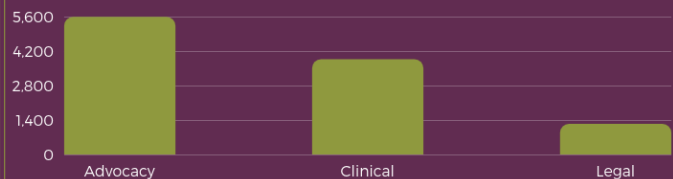

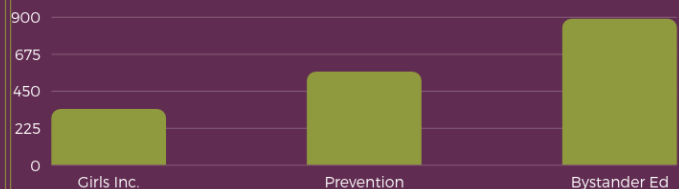

The Massachusetts White Ribbon Campaign is a part of a worldwide movement for human rights that engages men and boys to help end violence against women and girls.

WHY SUPPORT?

In order to break the cycle of violence before it affects the next generation, the Center offers an innovative Youth Empowerment Services (YES) Program that uses evidence-based and nationally-recognized approaches to educate and engage girls and boys in breaking the cycle of domestic violence. Through three linked initiatives, we empower girls, foster healthy dating relationships, and engage boys and girls in violence prevention. We are currently reaching students in upper elementary school through high school. Last year, YES programming was provided to 1,582 students and faculty in 8 schools across Essex County.
